The New Testament

GROWING IN THE KNOWLEDGE OF JESUS CHRIST... BY LOVING THE BRETHREN

Hebrews 13:1; 1 Thessalonians 4:9-10

INTRODUCTION... In this series of lessons, we have used 2 Peter 1:5-8) in learning about the eight special virtues that we must have as a part of our Christian life. This morning we will look at *brotherly kindness*, a necessary element in developing a Christ-like character.

I. Brotherly Kindness Defined

- (A) From the Greek words, *Phileo* (love) and *adelphos* (brother).
- (B) As used in the New Testament. (Hebrews 13:1; 1 Thessalonians 4:9-11)
 - (1) 1 Peter 1:22; Romans 12:10

II. The Demand Of Brotherly Kindness

- (A) It is necessary to know God. (1 John 4:7-8, 34-20-21)
- (B) It is necessary to be Jesus' disciples. (John 13:34-35; 2 John 9)
- (C) It is necessary for unity. (John 17:20-23)
 - (1) Ephesians 4:2-3

III. The Development Of Brotherly Kindness

- (A) Requires a pure soul. (1 Peter 1:22-23)
- (B) Requires being taught by God. (1 Thessalonians 4:9-10)
 - (1) John 4:9-10; 1 John 3:16
- (C) Requires spending time with the brethren.
- (D) Requires praying for brethren. (James 5:16)

IV. The Display Of Brotherly Kindness

- (A) Affects our attitude toward brethren. (Romans 15:1)
 - (1) 1 Corinthians 8:13; Galatians 5:13
 - (2) James 4:11-13
- (B) Affects our service toward brethren.
 - (1) 1 Thessalonians 5:14
 - (2) Romans 14:19

CONCLUSION... As we give thought as to what it means to grow in the knowledge of Jesus Christ, and to develop a Christ-like character, we must appreciate the importance of growing a strong love for the brethren. "May the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and to all, just as we do to you, so the He may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all His saints." (1 Thessalonians 3:12-13).
