


Godly Wives and Mothers


COMMUNITY OUTREACH MINISTRY

Introduction... Mother's Day was instituted as a national holiday by President Woodrow Wilson in 1914, to be observed for the second Sunday of May. As with other holidays, we must be careful that it does not become so commercialized that it loses some of its meaning. This morning we will examine the Scriptures to see what mother's truly deserve...

E. Righteousness

(1) Proverbs 23:24-25; Romans 3:21-22

F. Care

(1) 1 Timothy 5:4, 8, 16; James 1:27
