YOUR LOAN HAS COME DUE! Luke 12:19-21

And I will say to my soul, "Soul, you have many goods laid up for many years; take your ease; eat, drink, and be merry." 'But God said to him, 'Fool! This night your soul will be required of you; then whose will those things be which you have provided?' "So is he who lays up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God."

What would you do if your home had a balloon payment due and you don't have the money? You look for family to help, take out another loan, tap your 401 or other avenues you may have, but it's not enough and it's too late!!!

Now your loan has come due at judgement and there is no one or no amount of money to BUY your way in, your family can't pray your soul in, and you can't beg your way in. What do you do now?

Hebrews 9:27 NKJV

And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgement,...

Think About It, "Stir-crazy".

Those words can be used to describe the feelings that come with being stuck in one place for far too long. Kids can feel stir-crazy when Summer days get taken over by rain and they can't go outside. Sometimes moms get stir-crazy when they find themselves realizing they haven't left the house in a long time. In a pandemic, people go stir-crazy when "stay at home" orders go from days to weeks.

Being stir-crazy can often trigger an emotional domino effect. Feeling stuck moves to unrest. Unrest moves to anxious thoughts. And then anxious thoughts start to feel like the walls are closing in and there's no hope.

When you recognize the feelings and emotions involved in this train of thoughts, you get to make a choice. Where will you turn for hope and a way forward?

While you could battle feeling stir-crazy with practical suggestions from the latest blog or Pinterest board, there is nothing like the answer of Scripture from God's perspective to help you pause and find real rest from it all.

God says, In every situation, come to Me with prayer and praise.

You say, No one understands.

You say, I am anxious.

God says, My peace transcends all understanding.

You say, I can't take this anymore.

God says, Throw it all on me.

When being stir-crazy triggers anxiety and unrest, stop today and take it all to the God who cares. He wants all of your emotions today, all of your messy stir-crazy feelings. God is ready to listen and bring peace.

Pray About It

Holy God, I confess that it's more natural for me to worry about what I can't control than it is to trust You. Forgive me for forgetting so easily how faithful and good You are. May Your Spirit teach me to rest in Your peace and turn my thoughts toward worship and gratitude. Amen.

Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things. 



WHO IS A WISE MAN?

James 3:13-18

Introduction... If we look across the entire spectrum, there are basically two categories of people, the *wise* and the *foolish*. This morning we will turn out attention and be concerned with *"who is a wise man."* Hopefully it will help us to fall into the realm of being wise.

WHO IS WISE?

I. The Man Who Refrains His Lips

- (A) A man who fails to refrain his lips renders his religion in vain
 - (1) Proverbs 10:19, 17:28, 29:11; James 1:26: Psalms 39:1

II. The Man Who Wins Souls

- (A) The Soul is man's most valuable Possession (Proverbs 11:30)
 - (1) Matthew 16:26; 2 Timothy 2:2; John 1:40-42

III. The Man Who Hears His Father's Instruction

- (A) Not heeding a Father's Instruction Makes on foolish
 - (1) Proverbs 13;1, 4:1; Ephesians 6:1; Colossians 3:20

IV. The Man Who Hears And Obeys (Matthew 7:24-27)

- (A) We Must be doers of the Word, not just Hearers
 - (1) Romans 2:13; James 1:22-25

V. The Man Who Makes Preparation (Matthew 25:1-13)

- (A) We Must be prepared for His Coming
 - (1) 2 Peter 3:10; Matthew 24:42-44

VI. The Man Who Redeems The Time (Ephesians 5:15-16)

- (A) To Redeem Time is to buy up each Opportunity
 - (1) Colossians 4:5; Psalms 19:12; 2 Corinthians 6:2

VII. The Man Who Knows The Scriptures (2 Timothy 3:15)

- (A) Wisdom Comes from Knowing the Scriptures!
 - (1) Ephesians 3:4; 2 Timothy 2:15

VIII The Man Who Shows His Works (James 3:13)

(A) James 2:14-26; Ephesians 2:9

Conclusion... In the Book of James explains what seeking wisdom is all about, and the Proverbs are dotted with verses concerning why wisdom is important. Following the plan of salvation laid out for us in the Bible is a certain way to show wisdom. I hope that this lesson stressed the value of wisdom.
